

# Wildlife Habitat Scavenger Hunt

## Element 1: Provide Food

- Berries and fruit from plants
- Nuts and seeds from plants
- Nectar from flowers
- Feeders (suet holders, bird feeders, hummingbird feeders)



## Component 2: Supply Water

- Birdbaths and bird waterers
- Fountains and waterfall rocks
- Pond
- Butterfly puddling areas
- Vernal (temporary) pools/puddles in rocks and depressions



## Element 3: Create Cover

- Native vegetation: trees and shrubs
- Thickets and leaf litter (leaves on the ground)
- Rock piles
- Rotting logs and wood piles
- Bat, butterfly, bee and toad houses



## Element 4: Provide Places to Raise Young

- Native vegetation: trees and shrubs
- Host plants for caterpillars
- Snags (standing dead trees)
- Meadows
- Nesting boxes



## Element 5: Use Sustainable Practices

- Limit water use and follow County W-8 Rule
- Plant plants with low water needs (xeric)
- Limit use of chemical pesticides, herbicides and fertilizers
- Use organic mulch and/or compost
- Use rain barrels, soaker hoses and drip irrigation
